First-aid Measures

Inhalation

Move to fresh air. Remove source of exposure or move to fresh air. Keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. If breathing is difficult, trained personnel should administer emergency oxygen if advised to do so by Poison Centre or doctor. Avoid mouth-to-mouth contact by using a barrier device. Call a Poison Centre or doctor if you feel unwell.

Skin Contact

Avoid direct contact. Wear chemical protective clothing if necessary. Quickly and gently blot or brush away excess chemical. Wash with plenty of water. Get medical advice or attention if you feel unwell or are concerned.

Eye Contact

Rinse the contaminated eye(s) with lukewarm, gently flowing water for 5 minutes, while holding the eyelid(s) open. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. If eye irritation persists, get medical advice or attention.

Ingestion

Rinse mouth with water. Never give anything by mouth if person is rapidly losing consciousness, or is unconscious or convulsing. Do not induce vomiting. If vomiting occurs naturally, lie on your side in the recovery position. Rinse mouth with water again. Avoid mouth-to-mouth contact by using a barrier device.
